### **Family Day: In Person**

#### **Valton Tyler's *Freezing Point***



This lesson plan contains the Texas TEKS for Elementary, Middle, and High School art teachers. ## Student Exhibitions:

### *2022 Day of the Dead Art Exhibition*

The Day of the Dead Middle School Art Exhibition is an annual event held at the TMA. Students between the grade levels of 5<sup>th</sup> grade – 8<sup>th</sup> grade are eligible to create artworks in their classrooms that celebrate the cultural festivities of *Día de los Muertos*.

The art activity is to be determined by the teacher and can be either a three-dimensional or a two-dimensional project. Once the project is completed, the teacher will select 30 – 35 pieces from each participating grade level to deliver to the museum. **The artwork will be delivered to the museum between October 10, 2022 – October 21, 2022, which includes weekends.**

The exhibition will be free and open to the public from October 30, 2022 – November 6, 2022. The museum will hold a reception for the event on November 5, 2022.
